### Arrive in Seward | Travel to Anchorage | Travel to Redoubt Bay

After disembarking from your cruise ship, you will be driven by private transfer to Anchorage along the spectacular Seward Highway. Midday, you will board a floatplane that offers spectacular views of the Cook Inlet en route to Redoubt Bay. From the Lodge, head out for an afternoon of fly-fishing or just enjoy the natural beauty of the Redoubt Bay Critical Habitat area. Accommodations are at the Redoubt Bay Lodge.


## Redoubt Bay Lodge

### Kenai, AK

Situated 50 minutes southwest of Anchorage by air, at the entrance to Lake Clark Pass, Redoubt Bay Lodge offers the only accommodations within a 171,000-acre critical habitat area. Accessible only by floatplane, the lodge is set on a knoll overlooking Big River Lakes. With one of the densest bear populations in the state, the Redoubt Bay area lends itself to bear viewing! Between mid-June and mid-August, as the bears wander down to the lake to fish for salmon, you will have the opportunity to see these majestic beasts up close—and in complete safety, with the aid of a naturalist and purpose-built boat.
