- THREE** Travel from Trout Rock Lodge to Yellowknife Airport for your flight to Edmonton | End of your journey



DAY ONE

Arrive in Yellowknife | Travel to Trout Rock Lodge

Your experience will begin at the Yellowknife Airport (flight access from Edmonton) where you will be greeted by lodge staff for your journey to the remote wilderness of Great Slave Lake. You will travel by van and Hagglund (an enclosed tracked tank-like vehicle ideal for the snowy north), or snowmobile. During the winter there is no running water, nor showers at the lodge. Washroom facilities include a Pacto Toilet. This is rustic, remote and winterized! Accommodations are at the Trout Rock Lodge.

Explore Great Slave Lake | Aurora Viewing

Today you will enjoy a memorable outdoor adventure, starting off with a snowmobile ride on Great Slave Lake to the perfect ice fishing spot, where you will fish for the lake's fierce Northern Pike or Ling Cod. You can also enjoy snowshoeing along the windswept shoreline or touring the area in one of the Hagglands. On your final evening, enjoy a hearty meal and viewing the Lights from the deck, or venture out onto the lake for a 360 degree view of the sky. Accommodations are at the Trout Rock Lodge.

The Trout Rock Lodge is located on the 100-mile North Arm of Great Slave Lake, the deepest and the 10th largest lake on earth, only an hour by land from Yellowknife. In the winter this lodge attracts those interested in a wintery experience to view the Aurora Borealis. During the day guests enjoy a range of activities including ice fishing, snowmobiling, snowshoeing and touring the area. At night it's a light show under the Auroral Oval. This lodge typifies classic Northern-style hospitality; it's rustic, authentic and full of passion for hosting guests in the remote wilderness.
