

DAY ONE

Arrive in Calgary | Drive to Lake Louise

Upon arrival at Calgary International Airport, you'll pick up your rental car and enjoy a scenic two-hour drive west along the Trans-Canada Highway towards the Canadian Rockies. Your day will end in beautiful Lake Louise, Canada's "Diamond in the Wilderness". Accommodations are at the Fairmont Château Lake Louise in a Fairmont Deluxe Lakeview Room.

DAY TWO

Dogsledding along the Continental Divide

Enjoy a true dogsledding adventure! Get to know the dogs and their guides, and learn the basics of mushing—then drive the team home. You'll cover over 16 km (9 mi.), travelling along and across the Continental Divide in Banff and Yoho National Parks. The afternoon is at your leisure; consider exploring nearby Emerald Lake and Yoho National Park, with the spectacular Takakkaw Falls. Accommodations are at the Fairmont Château Lake Louise in a Fairmont Deluxe Lakeview Room.



Travel from Jasper to Banff





Fairmont Château Lake Louise

Lake Louise, AB

A recipient of the AAA Four Diamond Award—and voted among the Top 50 Ski Resorts by Condé Nast Traveler—the Fairmont Château Lake Louise is a traditional luxury hotel. It is located on the shores of the emerald waters of Lake Louise, facing the majestic Victoria Glacier, just 5 minutes' drive from the village. The 469 guest rooms overlook either the lake or forest, and the hotel's amenities include eight restaurants and lounges, a Health Club, and Escape Spa & Salon.

Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge

Jasper, AB

A recipient of the AAA Four Diamond Award, this cabin-style resort hotel is located 15 minutes from the town site of Jasper, on the shores of Lac Beauvert. Its 446 rooms are spread among a "village" of 56 chalets and heritage log cabins—in addition to the main lodge—all of which are connected by paths on a 903-acre property. The hotel features nine restaurants and lounges, a health/fitness centre with heated outdoor pool, and a full spa.



Fairmont Banff Springs
