Whale Watching in Point Adolphus

Glacier Bay National Park Boat Cruise

Boat into the waterways of Glacier Bay National Park and watch as tidewater glaciers calve in front of you. Keep alert for rookeries full of puffins, scan the rock formations for mountain goats and brown bears, and pass by Marble Island and its resident sea lion clan. Take a scenic flight back to the park entrance. You'll soar through the awe-inspiring Alaska Range, over glaciers, and to the North Face of Denali. Complete the journey to Anchorage on the world-famous Alaska Railroad GoldStar dome train. From the open-air platform or glass-covered observation deck, you'll soak up views of tundra, deep river canyons, and mountains—including magnificent Denali. Set on a ridge above the small community of Talkeetna on the south side of Denali, the Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge offers unforgettable views of Denali and the Alaska Range. The 212 guest rooms are complemented by two restaurants, a bar, a business center, and a spacious lobby featuring a 46-foot river rock fireplace. The seasonal, four-diamond property, which is located two and a half hours north of Anchorage, rests on 35 acres and comprises eight buildings: a main lodge, five guest lodges, employee housing, and a maintenance facility.
