Travel to Seal River Heritage Lodge

A commercial flight will transport you to Churchill, from where you will be flown by helicopter or fixed wing aircraft to the lodge. This exciting flight takes you out over the Churchill River, and then northwest up the rugged Hudson Bay coastline. Keep a sharp eye out for caribou, moose, seals, wolves, and of course polar bears. Accommodations are at Seal River Heritage Lodge.

A 30-minute flight from Churchill, this polar bear viewing lodge is one of the best spots around to see the great ice bears in July, August, October, and November, whether it is from one of the nature trails, the lodge’s viewing tower, or just outside the expansive picture windows as you dine. It is also ideal for spotting the Northern Lights, and for viewing belugas in July and August, when thousands of the whales gather in the Seal River estuary.
