### TRANSFER WITH GLACIER DOGSLEDDING

4 HOURS

On this private scenic transfer between the Seward ship dock and the Anchorage International Airport or hotel, you'll enjoy a brief helicopter flight and a glacier dogsledding trip. After your helicopter ride has deposited you on the glacier, your guide will explain the origins of this special breed of dogs, mushing history, and the Iditarod Race. You will have the opportunity to help harness the dogs, and you'll witness the excitement as they are put in front of a sled. Then, accompanied by your guide, you'll take to the trail. This is a quintessential Alaskan experience—not to be missed.

## TRANSFER WITH ATV ADVENTURE


7 HOURS

This private scenic transfer between the Seward Cruise Terminal and the Anchorage International Airport or your hotel includes a stop at The Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center and a guided ATV adventure. After traveling to the Bird Creek Trailhead, you will become acquainted with your ATV and some safety guidelines, then take a test ride before setting off on your adventure. The first stop is about 20 minutes up the trail at Penguin Creek—an excellent opportunity for pictures. Continuing up the trail to an alpine meadow, you'll be able to scan the upper elevations for sheep, moose, and bear.

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

Visiting an eagle's nest, and (depending on the season) a waterfall to observe spawning salmon

## REDOUBT BAY LODGE BEAR VIEWING & HISTORY TOUR

10 HOURS

On this wilderness adventure, your private driver will transfer you from the Seward Cruise Terminal to Lake Hood, America's largest floatplane base. From there, you will fly 50 minutes across Cook Inlet to the Redoubt Bay Bear Sanctuary. After lunch at the Redoubt Bay Lodge, you'll spend three hours in a boat viewing bears at any one of five salmon spawning streams accessible by boat from the lodge. This is one of the safest and most comfortable ways to view bears up close.

#### HIGHLIGHTS

Viewing majestic brown bears in their natural habitat – this is a jaw-dropping once-in-a-lifetime experience!
