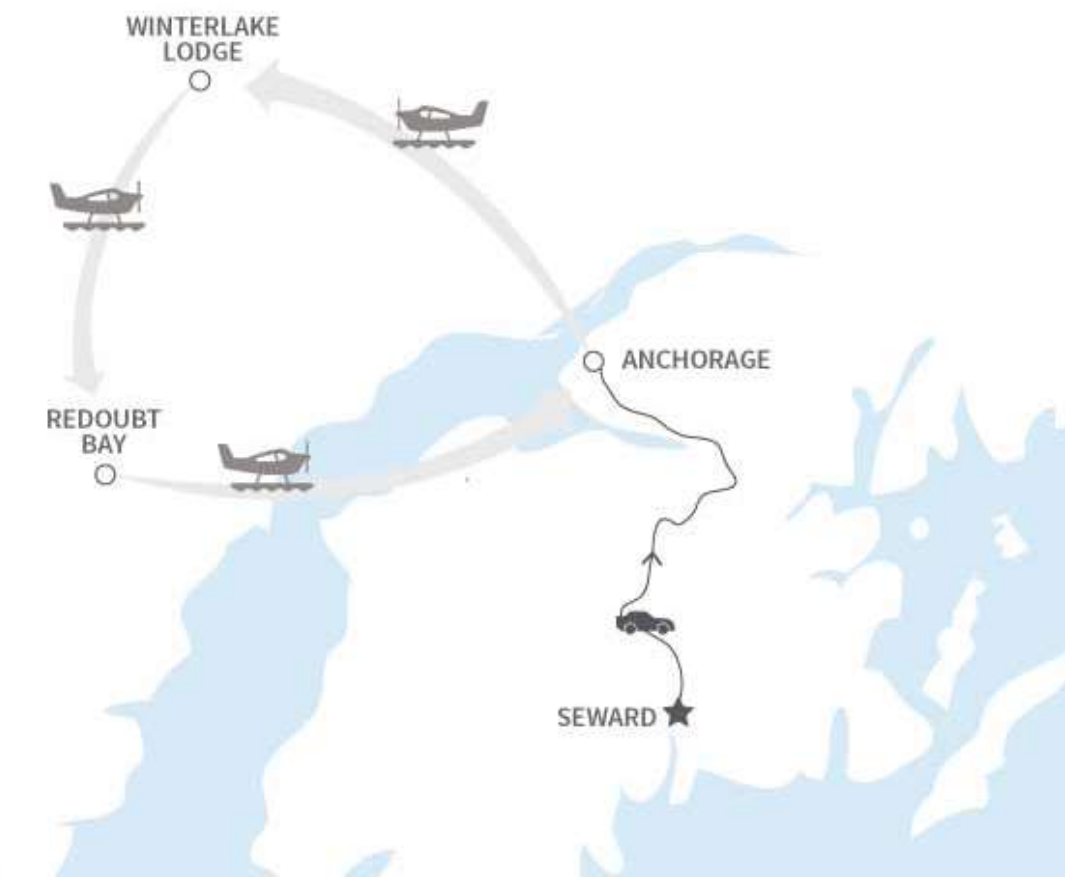

DAY ONE

Arrive in Seward | Travel to Anchorage

After disembarking from your cruise ship, you will be driven by private transfer to Anchorage along the spectacular Seward Highway. Before enjoying lunch on your own in Anchorage, you'll stop to visit the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center, meeting some of Alaska's friendliest (and furriest!) locals. In the afternoon you'll spend some time at the Alaska Native Heritage Center, learning about Alaska's Indigenous people through exhibits and live demonstrations. Accommodations are at the Hotel Captain Cook in a Junior Suite.

Travel to Finger Lake | Lodge Adventures

A private SUV will deliver you from your hotel to Lake Hood for your scheduled seaplane Flight to Winterlake Lodge. While at Winterlake enjoy both lodge and helicopter-led adventures, including hiking, fishing, rafting and glacier trekking. Other options include yoga, kayaking, birding and cooking classes. Wine tastings in the early evenings explore food and wine pairings, and allow for the day's tales to be shared. Accommodations are at Winterlake Lodge in a Cabin.

Travel to Redoubt Bay Bear Sanctuary

Board a floatplane for a flight that will take you through the scenic Tordrillo Mountains and Triumvirate Glacier en route to Redoubt Bay Bear Lodge, located on the Kenai Peninsula. Thanks to the rich salmon population in nearby Big River Lakes, the bears flock to Redoubt for a hearty meal, so keep your eyes peeled for these majestic creatures. Enjoy a day and a night at Redoubt Bay Lodge, where the activity options abound. You may wish to take in the incredible scenery on a hike, a kayak of Big River Lakes or turn your eyes upward to spot the millions of birds that migrate and nest in the region. Accommodations are at Redoubt Bay Lodge in a Cabin.

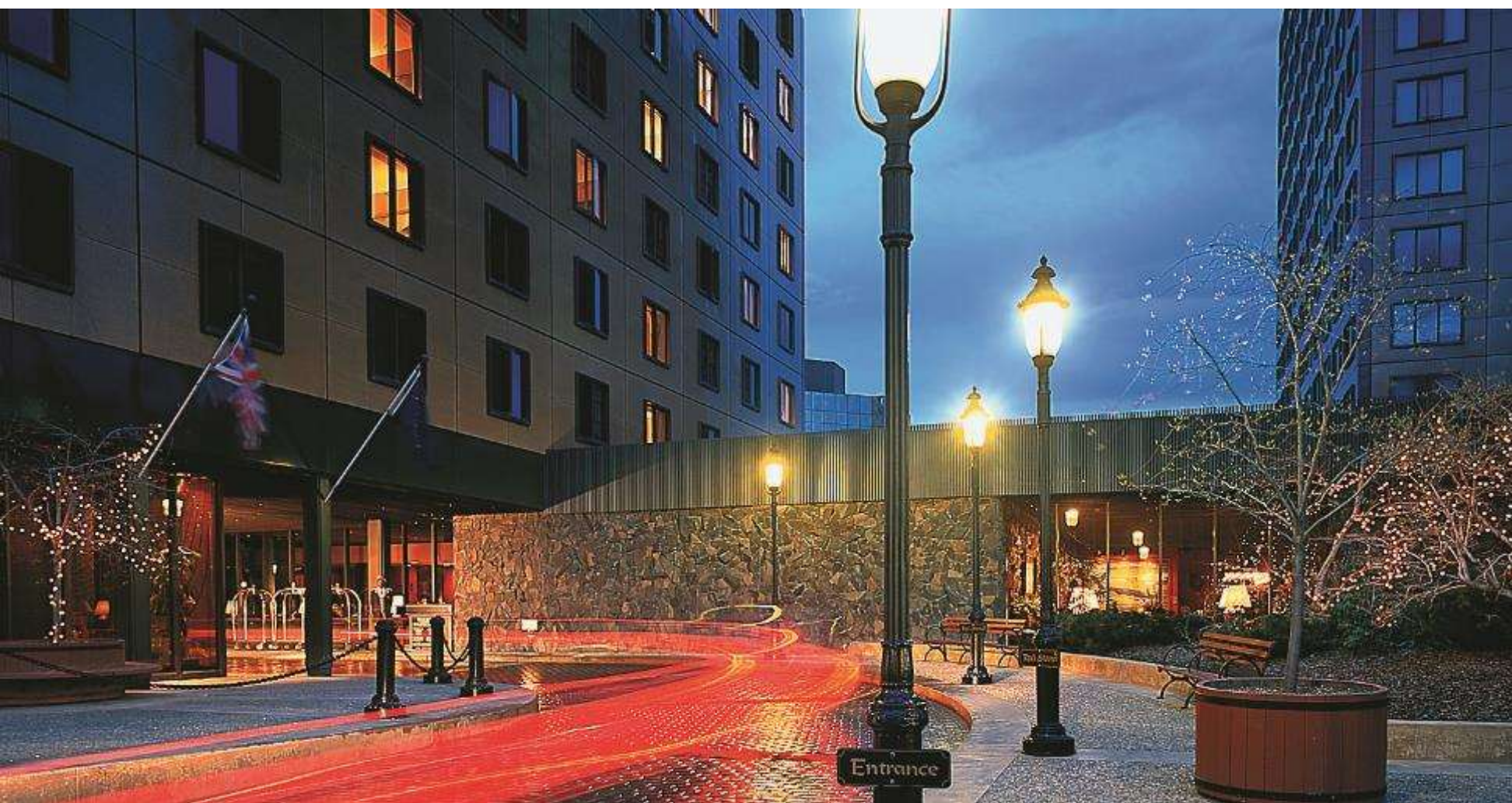
Winterlake Lodge

Redoubt Bay Lodge

Kenai, AK

Situated 50 minutes southwest of Anchorage by air, at the entrance to Lake Clark Pass, Redoubt Bay Lodge offers the only accommodations within a 171,000-acre critical habitat area. Accessible only by floatplane, the lodge is set on a knoll overlooking Big River Lakes. With one of the densest bear populations in the state, the Redoubt Bay area lends itself to bear viewing! Between mid-June and mid-August, as the bears wander down to the lake to fish for salmon, you will have the opportunity to see these majestic beasts up close—and in complete safety, with the aid of an naturalist and purpose-built boat.
