

CHURCHILL WILD SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

- _____ **Carry-On Items** – Airline tickets, travel documents, travellers' cheques, credit cards, money, any valuables, luggage keys, sunglasses, prescription glasses/contact lenses, camera, film and/or memory cards, flash, extra batteries, binoculars, tripod (optional) earplugs (to wear on the plane to the lodge), and prescription medication (in original containers).
- _____ **Long Underwear** – Thermax or polypro-type top and bottom
- _____ **Socks** – Warm wool hiking socks, i.e. SmartWool
- _____ **Sleepwear** – Warm sleepwear (as nights are generally chilly)
- _____ **Shirts** – Three to four long sleeved and two to three short sleeved shirts
- _____ **Sweaters** – Heavy fleece and/or wool pullover
- _____ **Jacket** – Parka or other warm coat
- _____ **Pants** – Ski-pants or other insulated pants
- _____ **Boots** – Insulated winter boots
- _____ **Indoor Shoes/Slippers** – For wearing around the lodge
- _____ **Hat** – Tuque (wool hat)
- _____ **Balaclava**
- _____ **Gloves/Mittens** – Heavy and warm, as well as lighter gloves for taking pictures
- _____ **Hand/Foot Warmers**
- _____ **Ski Goggles**
- _____ **Small Pack Sack** – For hikes
- _____ **Hairdryer** (not provided at the lodge)
- _____ **Miscellaneous** – Shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant, sunscreen, SPF lip balm, pocket-size Kleenex, water bottle, and Ziploc bags (to wrap your camera equipment in prior to bringing it inside the warm lodge. **Note:** The sudden rush of warm air will create condensation in your cold camera gear which will likely damage it, so please wrap it up tight and leave it in the bag until it has warmed up.)

Note: Please wear your bulky outdoor gear on the flight to the lodge. You are allowed **one small carry-on** to be used to pack the essentials (medication, camera, etc.). No large camera bags or large backpacks are allowed. A camera may be carried around your neck.
