

# TORDRILLO MOUNTAIN LODGE GETAWAY

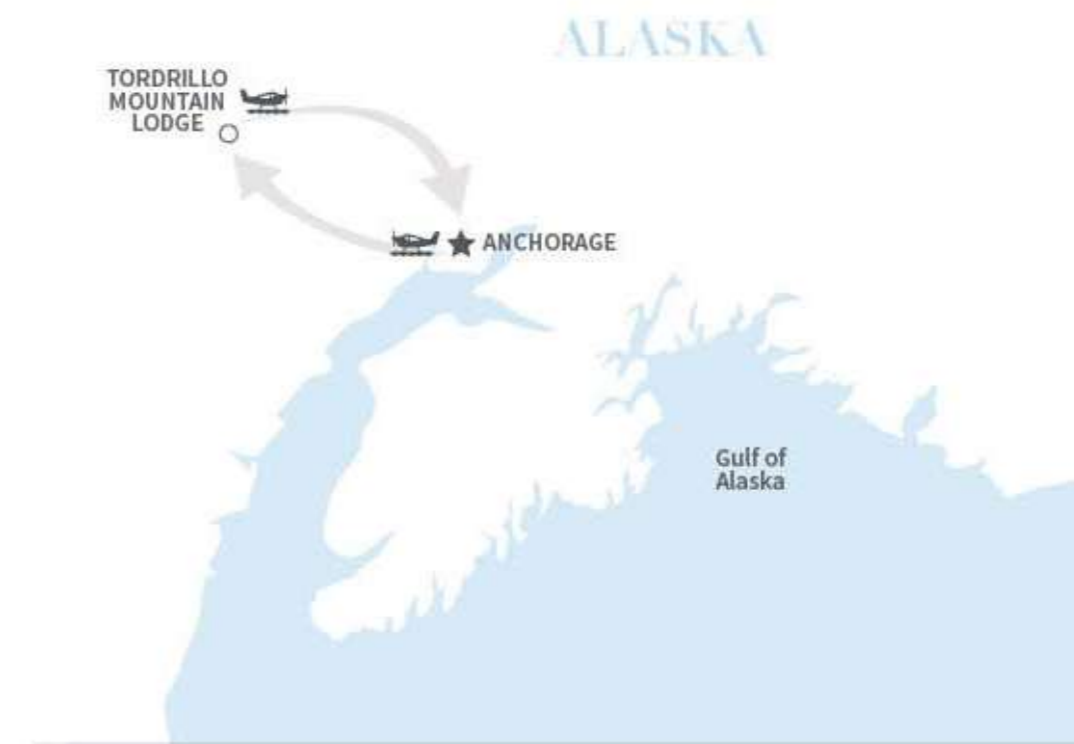

Take to the skies over the next two days for helicopter-led adventures from your base at Tordrillo Mountain Lodge. Along with your expert guide, enjoy helicopter led hiking where you can spot wildlife, trek across ancient glaciers or picnic in meadows of wildflowers. Another day of helicopter-led adventures will take you riverside for legendary helicopter fishing. Wade through the river in search of fish, hopping on a raft when the waterways deepen. ### Judd Lake, Alaska

Tordrillo Mountain Lodge, just a 40-minute flight from Anchorage, is a remote, multi-sport luxury lodge in the heart of the Alaska Tordrillo Range. Located on the banks of the Talachulitna River and Judd Lake, it is within view of two 11,000-foot volcanoes and Denali, North America's tallest peak at 20,320-feet. A blend of posh amenities and rustic Alaskan architecture, this 5,600-foot log structure has walls of windows and three large cedar decks that overlook Judd Lake and the Alaska Range. In addition to the deluxe guest rooms, the family room and grand living room offer a cozy atmosphere for fireside chats, reading, or relaxing with a glass of hand-selected wine from the 500-bottle cellar.
